We have created this privacy statement in order to demonstrate our firm and continuing commitment to the privacy of personal information provided by those visiting and interacting with this web site. We hold the privacy of your personal information in the highest regard. The following discloses our information gathering and dissemination practices for this website. This privacy policy discloses the privacy practices for www.ckgalleria.com and www.qigong.ckgalleria.com. This privacy policy applies solely to information collected by this web site.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

Cookies
